This is the Cookie Policy for <https://www.cnnnect.com/> ("we", "us" and the "Site"). The Site is operated on behalf of CNNECT AGENCY LIMITED trading as CNNECT. We are committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy sets out our use of cookies on our Site. It should be read in conjunction with our <https://www.cnnnect.com/privacy>.

How do we use cookies?

Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and allows us to improve our site

What are cookies and how do they work?

Cookies are pieces of information that a website transfers to your hard drive to store and sometimes track information about you. Most web browsers automatically accept cookies, but if you prefer, you can change your browser settings to prevent this. However, you may not be able to take full advantage of our website if you do so. Cookies are specific to the server that created them and cannot be accessed by other servers, which means they cannot be used to track your movements around the web. Although they do identify a user's computer, cookies do not personally identify users and passwords and credit card information are not stored in cookies.

What sort of cookies do we use?

We use the following types of cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These are cookies that are required for the operation of our website and under our terms with you. They include, for example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of our website.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when online. This helps us for our legitimate purposes to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are navigating the site with ease.
- **Functionality cookies.** These are used to recognise you when you return to our website. This enables us, subject to your choices and preferences, to personalise our content for you and remember your preferences (for example, your choice of language or region).
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to our website, the pages you have visited and the links you have followed. We will use this information subject to your choices and preferences to make our website and the advertising displayed on it more relevant to your interests. We may also share this information with third parties for this purpose.

How do you disable cookies?

The effect of disabling cookies depends on which cookies you disable, but in general the website may not operate properly if cookies are switched off. If you only disable third party cookies, you will not be prevented from making purchases on our sites. If you disable all

cookies, you will be unable to complete a purchase on our sites. See below for details of how to use common types of browsers to disable cookies.

Disabling cookies in Internet Explorer:

1. Click the three dots in the top right of your screen and select “Settings”
2. Select “Privacy & security”
3. From the “Cookies” drop down menu, select your preferred setting

Disabling cookies in Google Chrome:

1. Choose Settings> Privacy and Security
2. Click "Site Settings," select “Cookies and site data”
3. Turn off “Allow sites to save and read cookie data”

Disabling cookies in Safari:

1. Open your Settings
2. Select “Safari”
3. Under “Privacy & Security”, turn on “Prevent Cross-Site Tracking” and “Block All Cookies”

Disabling cookies in Firefox:

1. Choose the menu "tools" then "Options"
2. Select “Privacy & Security" and under “Enhanced Tracking Protection” select “Custom”
3. Select the “Cookies” checkbox
